# The President's Cup International Karate Tournament Rome 04/05 april 2020 "Palatorrino" Sport Hall - Via Fiume Giallo 47/65

This is an International competition, dedicated to our friend Daniele Lazzarini who died prematurely, open to all athletes of any organization, Italian and foreign Federations, organized in collaboration with Libertas and Lazio Regional Committee, in the following age classes and categories, valid for the "Borsa di studio" \* exclusively for FKI affiliated clubs.

**Referees**: the event wants to be actually a unifying and sheer moment, independent of different federations, organizations and clubs can register their own referee, provided they are certified, sending their availability by email. Before the start of competition there will be a briefing for all referees.

# **Kata Competition**

Kata's choice is according to federation rules which can be consulted on the federal website www.karateitalia.eu (please note that the same kata may be repeated in different rounds for athletes up to orange belt). Kata competition will be **Interstyle** (separate ranking by style only from Cadets category to Veterans).

All belts For athletes registration it's mandatory: day, month and year of birth.

Both in Kata and Kumite competitions Cadet athletes can also compete in Juniores category while the Under-21 athletes can also compete in the Seniors category.

The organization accepts no responsibility for any accident that may occur to persons or property before, during and after the event. All participating atlete must be in compliance with the medical certificates of suitability provided by the laws in force (with the registration to the competition the president of the sport association to which atlete belong assumes responsibility for compliance with this requirement, implicitly declaring that medical certificates are registered at their registered office).

# **REGISTRATIONS**

For all registration send mail to: federazionefki@libero.it no later than 27 March 2020 together with receipt of payment of all fees otherwise there will be the exclusion from competition.

Individual competition fee is 25 € for every athlete, each category. The fees must be paid by bank transfer to: UNI CREDIT FILIALE 30001 headed to Karate Italia IBAN IT 05 T 02008 05003 000104702583. Please note that entries received after the deadline will not be accepted.

AWARDS: First three athletes of each category and specialty will be awarded with a medal.

There will be a medal for participation in all kids and children categories and a diploma for all participants. There will be Cups for the top five ranked clubs.

Saturday 4 April from 2:00 Pm will begin all KATA categories from Cadets to Veterans.

Sunday 5 April from 8:00 Am will begin all KUMITE categories from Cadets to Veterans.

Sunday 5 April from 3:00 Pm will begin KATA and KUMITE categories for Kids A and B - Children C and D and Disabled Athletes.

The detailed timetable of competition will be published on the official FKI website www.karateitalia.eu and sent to clubs registered for the event, by 2 April 2020. This is to avoid unnecessary waiting for athletes and make the event more enjoyable for everyone.
